The Course will establish, augment, and solidify foundational research knowledge and skills of early career obstetrician gynecologist specialist faculty and subspecialist faculty and fellows. PROGRESS will also establish and engage a network of experienced and emerging researchers that together will promote, sustain, and empower course participants' research careers while furthering the health and welfare of women and gender-diverse persons cared for by obstetricians and gynecologists.

The **PROGRESS** Course will:

- Enable participants to create a meaningful foundation for their research
- Help participants create a network of engaged researchers
- Provide participants with ongoing mentoring by **PROGRESS** faculty
